Registration Fee: \$150 per team to be paid to finalize the registration process. **Step #1:** Submit your completed registration form & insurance documents to Dan Kalar.

Step #2: Dan will review paperwork and contact you to collect \$150 registration fee payment. **Registration closes August 15, 2018.** Limited to the first 24 completed registrations.

CONDITIONS:

(1) Registration is not considered complete until the fully completed and signed Team Registration Form is received along with supporting documents. (2) All cancellations must be submitted to the Event Organizer, in writing at least 1 week in advance of the event. Substitutions will be permitted from the same company any time prior to the event. (3) The sponsors, HNA and ICPI are not responsible for expenses incurred due to cancellation of the championship. (4) All participants who are found to be under the influence of drugs or alcohol during the Regional Installer Championship will be immediately dismissed from the competition. (5) The decision of the judges is final. (6) Failure to comply with the rules or conditions of the Championship by any team member will result in the team's disqualification.

CHAMPIONSHIP RULES:

(1) Registration is limited to the first twenty-four (24) teams to submit completed registrations. (Step 1) Obtain proof of their general liability and workers compensation insurance coverage. (Step 2) Complete the Team Registration Form and have each team member sign it. (Step 3) Submit the insurance documents and Team Registration Form to the Event Organizer. (2) Each team must have two (2) crew members and may choose to register one (1) crew alternate, each of whom must sign and date this Team Registration Form. (3) Each construction area may or may not be under a tent and the Regional Installer Championship will proceed regardless of typical weather conditions. In extreme weather events, the Event Organizer may elect to delay or postpone the event. (4) Teams must attend the pre-event meeting scheduled by the Event Organizer to review the judging criteria and rules of the Regional Installer Championship. Teams are required to be at their designated construction area not less than 15 minutes prior to the start of the round they are competing in. Failure to report at these times will constitute a withdrawal from the Regional Installer Championship. (5) At the pre-event meeting, teams will be randomly placed in a preliminary round and assigned a construction area. (6) Each team must provide their own tools and personal safety equipment. The Event Organizer will determine if specific tools or equipment are considered unsafe or provide an unfair advantage and will not be allowed. Typically, only small, non-powered, hand tools will be allowed. The Event Organizer may elect to provide some tools or equipment. (7) All materials to be used in the construction will be provided and placed in the team's assigned area. Pre-cut or discarded materials left from previous rounds cannot be used in the construction. Teams cannot supply their own materials. (8) The Event Organizer will determine if there will be

multiple preliminary rounds and how many teams will compete in each preliminary round based on the total number of teams registered, time limits, space constraints and materials available. (9) During each preliminary round, all teams will construct an 8'x10' patio area within 60 minutes as detailed in the supplied drawing which will require the installation of a herringbone field, soldier course, bedding sand, edge restraint, and complete the initial paver compaction. Do not fill joints with sand or perform the final compaction. (10) If the Event Organizers has planned for multiple preliminary rounds, each construction area must be returned to its original state so the subsequent team may compete without any noticeable advantage or disadvantage. (11) During the final round, each team will be given ninety (90) minutes to complete their construction, according to their own creative design in the assigned construction area using the materials provided. (12) During the Preliminary and Championship rounds, if a team chooses to withdraw from the Championship before they start construction, during construction, or is not at their construction area at the prescribed start time, they will be withdrawn from the competition and not ranked. (13) Teams that do not include all required elements or do not complete their project within the allotted time will still receive a score. (14) During the Preliminary round(s) each team's score will be calculated based on completeness, compliance to industry guidelines, safety, quality and craftsmanship as detailed in the Preliminary Round Judging Forms. Each judge will observe and score the construction activities of each team. Judges will work as a team to conduct and score the final inspection. (15) The team's Preliminary Round Total Score will be the sum of their score from the construction phase for all three judges and the final inspection judge team during the preliminary round. (16) At the end of the all preliminary round(s) each team will be ranked based on their Preliminary Round Total Score. The four teams with the highest Preliminary Round Total Scores out of all preliminary round(s) will advance to the Championship round. (17) During the Championship round each team's score will be calculated based on completeness, compliance to industry guidelines, safety, quality, craftsmanship and creativity as detailed in the Championship Round Judging Forms. Each judge will observe and score the construction activities of each team. Judges will work as a team to conduct and score the final inspection. (18) The team's Championship Round Total Score will be the sum of their score from the construction phase for all three judges and the final inspection judge team during the Championship round. (19) At the end of the Championship round, only the scores from the final round will be used to rank the teams. In the case of a tie, the judges will determine the final ranking. (20) The team ranked highest will be declared the "Regional Installer Champion".

The undersigned warrants that he/she shall indemnify, defend and hold harmless the ICPI, its officers, directors, employees, volunteers and authorized agents and the Event Organizer, its officers, directors, employees, volunteers and authorized agents from and against any and all third party claims, actions, causes of action, losses, liabilities, judgments, injuries (including death) or damages to persons or property, costs and expenses, including reasonable attorneys' fees and court costs, asserted against ICPI and/or the Event Organizer and arising out of or resulting from the undersigned's knowing and voluntary participation in the Regional Event completion. This duty of indemnification shall survive the conclusion of the Regional Event and competition.
